




## tropical frog














# beautiful butterfly

Building a butterfly in LEGO is lots of fun as they are very colorful creatures! For the rounded wing shape I used a combination of curved pieces and arches. The two arches give a nice shape to the bottom of the wing and point it in the right direction. Curved slopes on the tops and sides of each wing round off the edges. I've used a 1x1 brick with stud to connect the wings.








# raccoon
