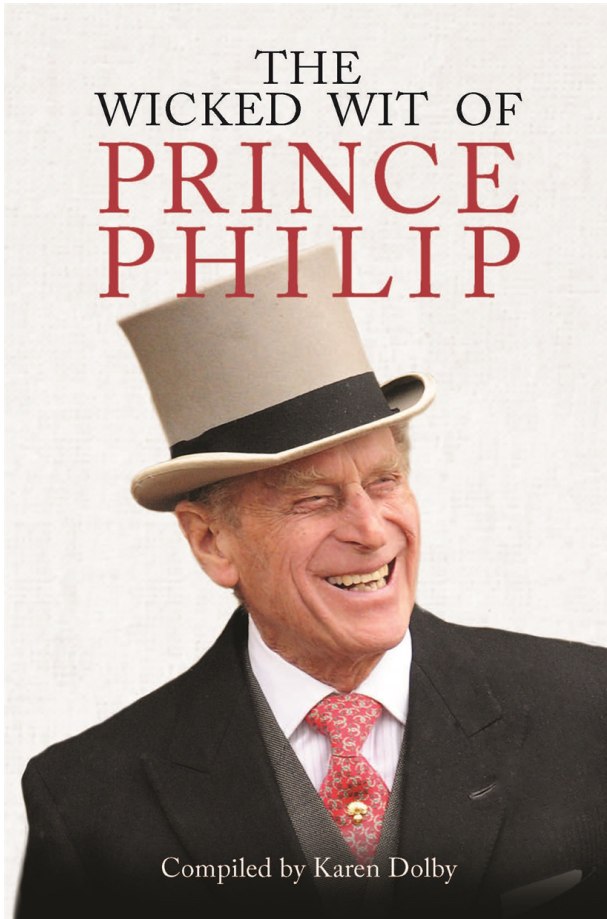


THE WICKED WIT OF PRINCE PHILIP
