Before You Begin

There are 12 dinosaurs in the pages of this book waiting to be brought to life.

To create each dinosaur, carefully press out the model, fold it in half and fold and hook the tabs together.

Some tabs are marked with a red dot. Fold these tabs flat against the inside of the model before you hook them together, so they are hidden from view.

Colour in the reverse side of each dinosaur if you like. The model can be folded in either direction, depending on which side you want to show.

There are two scenes at the back of the book to display your dinosaurs against. Carefully remove these pages and fold along the lines to create colourful backgrounds.
