Sally is a flight attendant and she is off on her next trip. Can you spot 10 differences between these two pictures? Circle the differences in picture B.




CAMP CONFUSION

Eva's going to Rome. She lives 1 hour 45 minutes from the airport.




Bill is going to New York. He lives just 30 minutes from the airport.
